ORDER:-

In the Government Order first read above a new Department, namely Department of Environment has been created as a Nodal Department for dealing with Environmental Management of the State. In the Government Order second read above, formation of a Green Squad for Coastal Conservation for checking Coastal Regulation Zone violations was sanctioned. In the Government order third read above, a post of Ranger among other posts was sanctioned temporarily for the Department. The Director of Environment has proposed to constitute the post of Ranger under the Tamil Nadu Forest Subordinate Service and submitted necessary draft ad-hoc rules for approval of the Government. The Government after careful consideration have decided to approve the draft ad-hoc rules submitted by the Director of Environment, Chennai.

2. The following Notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette:-

NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following Rules:-

2. The Rules hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 29th March 2005.

RULES.

The General and the Special Rules applicable to the holders of the permanent post of Ranger in Category-1 of Class-I of the Tamil Nadu Forest Subordinate Service shall apply to the holders of the temporary post of Ranger in the Department of Environment, subject to the modifications specified in the following rules:-

2. **Constitution.**— The post shall constitute a separate category in a distinct class of the said service.

3. **Method of Appointment** — Appointment to the post shall be made by transfer from the post of Ranger in Category-I of Class-1 of the Tamil Nadu Forest Subordinate Service.

4. **Appointing Authority :** The appointing authority for the post shall be the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests.

5. **Pay :** There shall be paid to the holder of the post a monthly pay calculated in the scale of pay of Rs.6500-200- 11000 :

Provided that on and from the 1st January 2006 the scale of pay is Rs.9300 – 34800 + Rs.4900 as a Grade Pay (Pay Band 2)
