ACTIVITY REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2012-13

Tamil Nadu was a forerunner in the environmental awareness movement. An initiative to form Eco-clubs to undertake environmental awareness activities fructified in 1998 and this was stepped up in the subsequent years. National Green Corps, a Government of India programme, under the Ministry of Environment and Forests, is being implemented in Government and Government aided schools of Tamil Nadu. This programme is being implemented in Tamil Nadu since 2002-2003. The Department of Environment is the Nodal Agency for implementing the National Green Corps (NGC) in Tamil Nadu.

At present, this programme is implemented in 8000 schools at the rate of 250 per district. A total of 3.50 lakhs students are involved in this programme with 40-50 students participating in each NGC school. One Teacher Coordinator, designated per school supervises the NGC activities. Each Educational District has an Environmental Awareness Coordinator, who was nominated on their own interests from academicians/NGOs/ teachers to oversee the NGC activities in the concerned educational district recommended by CEO.

As children are future citizens of our country, the most important segment of our population and the future custodian of Mother Nature, this programme imparts Environment Awareness to the Schools students through on –campus and community activities like Awareness progremme, tree planting, Green day celebration, Eco competitions and Eco camps. From the year 2009-10, this programme is implemented through the Environment Management Agency of Tamil Nadu (EMAT).

OBJECTIVES

- To make children understand environment and environmental problem.
- To provide environmental education opportunities for school children.
- To utilize the unique position of school children as conduits for awareness of the society at large.
- To facilitate children's participation in decision making in areas related to environment and development.
- To bring children into direct contact with the environmental problems facing the society they live in and make them think of solutions.
- To involve children in action based programme related to environment in their surroundings.



EVENTS ORGANIZED IN CONNECTION WITH INFORMATION, EDUCATION AND COMMUNICATION CAMPAIGN TO ESCHEW NON DEGRADABLE PLASTICS.

The Department of Environment in collaboration with the DHAN Foundation organized the Information, Education and Communication campaign to eschew non degradable plastics. Events were organized by involving the school students, men and women SHG members, NGC volunteers and general Public.

Walkathon has been coordinated by SHG federation in their respective districts and NGC coordinators and FCO coordinators in the Collector's office have actively participated. ONE-DAY TRAINING PROGRAMME ON BIODIVERSITY AT ZOO SCHOOL, VANDALUR

The ENVIS Centre, Department of Environment conducted a one day training programme on wild life for the NGC school children. This training programme was conducted at the Zoo school in Arignar Anna Zoological Park School, Vandalur on the 29th March 2012. AN IDENTIFICATION FIELD MANUAL TO THE FOREST TREES OF TAMIL NADU

The Environmental Information System (ENVIS) Centre of the Department of Environment has published Book titled "An Identification Field Manual to the Forest Trees of Tamil Nadu" The book was published under the Part – II scheme sanctioned by the Government of Tamil Nadu. This was an initiative to help in the easy identification of the little known forest trees of Tamil Nadu. This identification manual has been complied in consultation with experts with immense field knowledge to make the identification of the tree species as simple as possible, so that the book can be used by students, researchers and Forest Department staff. The use of symbols for Red listed (IUCN), traded species, medicinal status etc, adds value to this book. The value of this book is further enhanced by the color photographs depicting the key identification feature of the trees. The use of common names in Tamil helps to break the language barrier as it can also be used by a layman to help in tree identification. Care has been taken to avoid too many scientific terms and the descriptions have been given in simple English to help in easy understanding



EARTH DAY 2012 - AN ONLINE APPEAL FROM THE DIRECTOR OF ENVIRONMENT

Inspired by the student anti-war movement, Gaylord Nelson, a U.S. Senator from Wisconsin realized that if he could infuse that energy with an emerging public consciousness about air and water pollution, it would force environmental protection onto the national political agenda. As a result, on the 22nd of April 1969, 20 million Americans took to the streets, parks, and auditoriums to demonstrate for a healthy, sustainable environment in massive coast-to-coast rallies. Thus, from 1970 onwards, this day was observed as the Earth Day. The Department of Environment, Government of Tamil Nadu is pioneer in creating Environmental awareness. On the 42nd Anniversary of Earth Day, the Director of Environment made an online appeal to the general public through the Department's website to put into practice ten simple steps to protect our Earth.

The Workshop on formulation of the Tamil Nadu State Environment Policy was conducted by the Department of Environment at Hotel GRT Grand, T. Nagar, Chennai on 5th April 2012. Malleshappa, I.F.S., Director of Environment, welcomed the Honourable Minister for Environment and the other delegates.

This book documents the tree species, shrubs, herbs, climbers, including 58 strict Endemics and Threatened Medicinal Plant species



confined to Kalakad Mundanthurai Tiger Reserve, Southern Western Ghats of Tamil Nadu, India.

VISIT OF THE PRINCIPAL SECRETARY TO GOVERNMENT, ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS DEPARTMENT TO KALAKAD MUNDANTHURAI TIGER RESERVE (KMTR) FOR INSPECTING THE FOREST CONSERVATION INITIATIVES

Thiru. C.V. Sankar, I.A.S., the Principal Secretary to Government, Environment and Forests Department, visited Kalakad Mundanthurai Tiger Reserve with a view to take up inspection of Kalakad Mundanthurai Tiger Reserve which forms part of Agasthiyarmalai Biosphere Reserve on 3rd, 4th and 5th August 2012.



The Principal Secretary was received by Dr. H. Malleshappa, I.F.S., Chief Conservator of

Forests and the Director of Environment at Mundanthurai, which is situated at 196 meter MSL, and the inspection was carried out. KMTR bears a large contiguous tract of about 400 sq. kms of wet evergreen forests located away from the equatorial region. There are 2254 species of angiosperms have been recorded in this reserve of which 58 species are red-listed and 29 species are strict endemic to Kalakad Mundanthurai Tiger Reserve. This Tiger



Reserve also supports a large number of mammalian fauna. All the 5 primates (Lion tailed Macaque, Bonnet Macaque, Nilgiri Langur, Common Langur and Slender Loris) of Peninsular India are found in KMTR. All the 14 endemic mammals of Western Ghats are found in KMTR. The inspection team went as high as 1567 mts. above MSL. The terrain was slippery, rough and rocky. The inspection team saw tiger pugmarks, and panther scratches, etc., as it was an indication of indirect sighting of carnivores in that area. The team also confirmed the presence of Tiger, Panther and other wild animals through the camera trap photos which were installed nearby. The Principal Secretary to Government appreciated action taken to ban the public visiting the Pothigai hills which would have definitely disturbed the virgin forest, landscape and also the wildlife. He further appreciated the works of the anti-poaching watchers who are committed in conservation and protection of Kalakad Mundanthurai Tiger Reserve.

ONE DAY TRAINING PROGRAMME FOR NCG/ ECO CLUB COORDINATORS AT HOSUR

Thiru. V. Balaji and Thiru. Ravikumar at Adiyaman College, Hosur, NGC and Eco club coordinators conducted one day training programme for the NGC coordinators. **Tamil Nadu State coordinator Thiru. L. GREEN DAYS



The name Vanamahotsava (the festival of trees) originated in July 1947 after a successful tree-planting drive was undertaken in Delhi in which national leaders like Jawaharlal Nehru, Dr. Rajendra Prasad etc. participated. The concept of this great festival for the nature lovers was first initiated by (Late) Shri. K.M. Munshi, the Union Minister for Food & Agriculture in the year 1950. People celebrate Vanamahotsava for a week during the month of July every year by planting trees in schools, offices, colleges, homes etc. In Tamil Nadu, the National Green Corps in 8000 schools and Eco-clubs in 5069 schools located in all the 32 districts has been launched. The main objectives of this programme Is to create awareness about the environment and the urgent need for conservation. During Vanamahotsava, the main activity undertaken by the NGC school students is planting of trees in and around their school campus.
