NATIONAL GREEN CORPS: ACTIVITY REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2013-14

Environment is one of the key areas of current human concern. Ironically and probably unknowingly, it is human beings themselves who are responsible for degrading, destroying and polluting it. The future generations shall have to reap the harvest of unplanned and insensitive approach that had irreparably damaged the relationship and harmony of human beings with the nature. The ill-effect is evident and future potentialities of destruction are immense. As is always the case, education is supposed to provide the solution. Consequently, all over the world and in India focus is on environment, its conservation and protection and concentrating on environmental awareness especially for students who are the future citizens of our country.

Tamil Nadu is a pioneer in the environmental awareness movement. An initiative to form eco-clubs to undertake environmental awareness activities fructified in 1998 and this was stepped up in the succeeding years. National Green Corps, a Government of India project, under Ministry of Environment and Forests, is being implemented in Government and Government aided schools of Tamil Nadu. This programme is being implemented in Tamil Nadu since 2002-2003. The Department of Environment is the Nodal Agency for implementing the National Green Corps (NGC) in Tamil Nadu.

This programme is being implemented in 8000 school at the rate of 250 per district. A total of 3.50 lakhs students are involved in this programme with 40-50 students partaking in each NGC school. One Teacher Coordinator, designated per school supervises the NGC activities. Each Educational District had an Environmental Awareness Coordinator, who is nominated on their own interests from academicians/NGOs/ teachers, to supervise the NGC activities in the concerned educational district.

As Children are 'Our Future', the most important segment of our population and the future curator of Mother Nature, this programme on Environment Awareness is for the school students through on-campus and community activities like awareness programme, tree planting, Green days' celebration, Eco competitions and Eco camps.

From the year 2009-10, this programme is implemented through the Environment Management Agency of Tamil Nadu (EMAT).

OBJECTIVES:

- To make children comprehend environment and environmental problem.
- To provide environmental education opportunities for school children.
- To utilize the inimitable position of school children as conduits for awareness of the society at large.
- To facilitate children's participation in decision making in areas related to environment and development.
- To bring children into direct contact with the environmental problems facing the society they live in and make them think of solutions.
- To initiate action based programme related to environment in children and their surroundings.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:

Financial assistance of Rs.2500/- per member school is released for NGC activities as continued support as Grant. This amount released to schools from the date of commencement as follows:

NGC TRAINING PROGRAMME IN 32 REVENUE DISTRICTS:

In order to provide various kinds of environmental information to the Teacher Coordinators , one day training programme to the NGC Teacher Coordinators is conducted every year under head "Strengthening and Monitoring" sanctioned by the Government of India. In the last two years 100 NGC member students, 10 Teacher Coordinators of NGC member schools and District Coordinators participated in the one day training programme. This year Thiru L.Durai, M.A., M.Phil, M.Sc., PGDYT (Yoga) State Coordinator, NGC had made all arrangements for training programmes in the State with fruitful interaction with Teacher Coordinators and obtained feedback details for further improvement of the programme. The Teacher Coordinators and others participated in the training programmes were provided with morning tea with biscuits, Lunch and Evening Tea with biscuits under the expenditure from NGC fund.

Since the Teacher Coordinators had to provide information to all students and conduct the programme on environmental awareness, training had been provided to the Teacher Coordinators during the year 2013-14.

The Water, Soil and Air Testing Kits funded by the Government of Tamil Nadu have been provided to all 32 District and demonstrations of the kits have been conducted for the Teacher Coordinators in training programme from 23-10-2013 to 28-2-2014.

29.06.2013 World Environment Day 2013 Celebrations at Government Dental College, Chennai


